The Security Council

- 1 *Recalling* its resolutions 1696 (2006), 1773 (2006) and 1747 (2007),
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3 *Reaffirming* the tenets of the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT) and the
4 importance of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) in ensuring the peaceful
5 use of nuclear technology,
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7 *Commending* the IAEA for its extensive efforts to resolve outstanding issues
8 regarding the nuclear program of the Islamic Republic of Iran,
9
10 *Affirming* the sovereignty of all Member States as articulated in the Charter of the
11 United Nations and their ability to pursue peaceful nuclear energy in conformity with
12 Articles I and II of the NPT,
13
14 *Ensuring* the consultation with Iran in all decision making with regards to non-
15 proliferation and Iran,
16
17 *Applauding* Iran for its willing cooperation and good faith negotiations with the
18 Security Council on the issue of compliance with the NPT and the IAEA,
19
20 *Commending* Iran for its agreement to adopt Modified Code 3.1 of the Nuclear
21 Non-Proliferation Treaty, conditional upon the below terms, pending official approval of
22 the national government of Iran,

24 1. *Decides* to lift financial and travel restrictions on Iran related to its nuclear
25 program contingent upon its renewed adoption of Modified Code 3.1;
26
27 2. *Calls* for the creation of a Work-Share Cooperative for nuclear programs that
28 shall;
29 (a) Create energy cooperatives between the Islamic Republic of Iran and any of
30 the following member states: France, Russia, China, the United Kingdom, and the United

33 States, which would require 5% of nuclear scientists and technicians at Iranian nuclear
34 sites to be nationals of other Work-Share Cooperative members, and an equal number of
35 Iranian national scientists placed in other Cooperative member-nations;

36 (b) Produce greater transparency of the Iranian Nuclear Program by requiring
37 scientists to report progress to their home governments on at least an annual basis;

38 (c) Foster cooperation and education among nations seeking peaceful nuclear
39 energy development;

40 (d) Guarantee the appropriate transfer of nuclear materials into Iran from the
41 Work-Share Cooperative member nations for the purpose of maintaining diplomatic
42 oversight of these materials;

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44 3. *Amends* current sanctions to allow the transfer of nuclear materials between
45 Iran and Work-Share Cooperatives for the exclusive purpose of peaceful energy use;

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47 4. *Calls upon* Work-Share Cooperative member nations and the IAEA to prepare
48 annual reviews of the above program analyzing Iranian compliance with this resolution;

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50 5. *Decides* that it shall, in the event that the reports specified in paragraph 4 show
51 that Iran has not complied with this resolution, adopt appropriate measures under Article
52 41 of Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations to persuade Iran to comply with
53 this resolution and the requirements of the IAEA and responsible membership in the
54 international community, and underlines that further decisions will be required should
55 such additional measures be necessary;

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57 6. *Decides* to remain seized of the matter.
