Situation in Iran

- States, which would require 5% of nuclear scientists and technicians at Iranian nuclear sites to be nationals of other Work-Share Cooperative members, and an equal number of Iranian national scientists placed in other Cooperative member-nations;
- (b) Produce greater transparency of the Iranian Nuclear Program by requiring scientists to report progress to their home governments on at least an annual basis;
- (c) Foster cooperation and education among nations seeking peaceful nuclear energy development;
- (d) Guarantee the appropriate transfer of nuclear materials into Iran from the Work-Share Cooperative member nations for the purpose of maintaining diplomatic oversight of these materials;
- 3. *Amends* current sanctions to allow the transfer of nuclear materials between Iran and Work-Share Cooperatives for the exclusive purpose of peaceful energy use;
- 4. *Calls upon* Work-Share Cooperative member nations and the IAEA to prepare annual reviews of the above program analyzing Iranian compliance with this resolution;
- 5. Decides that it shall, in the event that the reports specified in paragraph 4 show that Iran has not complied with this resolution, adopt appropriate measures under Article 41 of Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations to persuade Iran to comply with this resolution and the requirements of the IAEA and responsible membership in the international community, and underlines that further decisions will be required should such additional measures be necessary:
