1 2	<i>Deeply concerned</i> by the altercation of 30 November 2009 on the border between Chad and Sudan,
3	
4	<i>Noting</i> the difficulties presented to Chad by the presence of refugees within their
5	borders,
6	
7	Alarmed by the possibility of continued forcible repatriation of Sudanese refugees
8	by the government of Chad,
9	
10	Acting under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations,
11	
12	1. Condemns the tragic loss of life of nationals of all involved nations;
13	
14	2. <i>Further condemns</i> the perpetrators of the violence and decides to investigate
15	the culpability of those who committed these acts;
16 17	2. Determines that the forced repetition of Sudanese refusees by the severement.
17	3. <i>Determines</i> that the forced repatriation of Sudanese refugees by the government of Chad constitutes a violation of international law and the Convention Relating to the
10	Status of Refugees (1951) in light of Security Council Resolution 7;
20	Status of Kelugees (1991) in light of Security Council Resolution 7,
21	4. Also determines that the attack of 30 November 2009 on UN peacekeepers and
22	Sudanese refugees demonstrates a disregard for the institution of the United Nations and
23	the Convention Relating to the Status of Refugees (1951);
24	
25	5. Demands that Chad immediately cease the repatriation of refugees to Sudan in
26	accordance with international law and the Convention Relating to the Status of Refugees
27	(1951), given the recent expansion of financial commitments to the humanitarian efforts
28	and the security agreement between Chad and France pursuant to MINURCAT;
29	
30	6. <i>Decides</i> to remain seized of the issue.

Passed by consensus, with 0 abstentions
