- 2 *Acknowledging* resolution S/RES/1325 which supports the eradication of women as the
- 3 prime victims to war crimes,
- 4
- 5 *Realizing* the exclusion of women from the processes of conflict prevention, resolution,
- 6 management, and peacebuilding,
- 7
- 8 *Recognizing* the value of gender perspectives in conflict prevention and peace building,
- 9
- 10 *Recalling* that women only lead one third of peace keeping operations, special political
- 11 missions and peacebuilding support offices within the UN,
- 12
- 13 1. *Recommends* the encouragement of the appointment of women through the United
- 14 Nation bodies in leading roles in peacekeeping operations, special political missions, and
- 15 peace-building support offices;
- 16
- 17 2. *Further Recommends* the discouragement of single gender delegations in the
- 18 Commission of Status Women and other United Nations bodies;
- 19
- 20 3. *Calls* for international, national, and local levels to provide training workshops that can
- 21 qualify women to partake in the processes of conflict prevention, resolution and peace
- 22 building;
- 23
- 24 4. *Requests* the participation of women in positions of the military, police force, and
- 25 justice system, which will enable women to provide valuable input and effective change;
- 26
- 27 5. *Recommends* Member States encourage women to actively participate in the political
- 28 process through engaging their right to vote, and by running for public office;
- 29
- 30 6. *Urges* the examination of existing political bodies within countries to promote the
- 31 removal of barriers of the discrimination of women;

33 7. *Encourages* the promotion of women to organize community groups that will serve as
34 advisory councils to sectors relevant to peace building, conflict intervention, and post
35 conflict peace building;

37 8. *Further* recommends the involvement of both genders at all levels of command
38 structures through mainstream gender perspectives into its operations, educating, and
39 training of officials;

41 9. *Desires* the implementation of youth programs to promote gender-sensitive education
42 to discourage the stigma of inequality;

44 10. *Recommends* that Member States promotes the Women's Development Fund aimed at
45 supporting the aforementioned women empowerment programs;

47 11. *Calls upon* UN Women to monitor and evaluate the progress of Member States in
48 respect to these measures to promote the empowerment of women.
