1 2 3 4	Acknowledging resolution S/RES/1325 which supports the eradication of women as the prime victims to war crimes,	
5 6 7	<i>Realizing</i> the exclusion of women from the processes of conflict prevention, resolution, management, and peacebuilding,	
, 8 9	Recognizing the value of gender perspectives in conflict prevention and peace building,	
10 11 12	<i>Recalling</i> that women only lead one third of peace keeping operations, special political missions and peacebuilding support offices within the UN,	
13 14 15 16	1. <i>Recommends</i> the encouragement of the appointment of women through the United Nation bodies in leading roles in peacekeeping operations, special political missions, and peace-building support offices;	
17 18 19	2. <i>Further Recommends</i> the discouragement of single gender delegations in the Commission of Status Women and other United Nations bodies;	
20 21 22 23	3. <i>Calls</i> for international, national, and local levels to provide training workshops that can qualify women to partake in the processes of conflict prevention, resolution and peace building;	
24 25 26	4. <i>Requests</i> the participation of women in positions of the military, police force, and justice system, which will enable women to provide valuable input and effective change;	
20 27 28 29	5. <i>Recommends</i> Member States encourage women to actively participate in the political process through engaging their right to vote, and by running for public office;	
29 30 31	6. Urges the examination of existing political bodies within countries to promote the removal of barriers of the discrimination of women:

- 33 7. *Encourages* the promotion of women to organize community groups that will serve as
- 34 advisory councils to sectors relevant to peace building, conflict intervention, and post
- 35 conflict peace building;

- 37 8. Further recommends the involvement of both genders at all levels of command
- 38 structures through mainstream gender perspectives into its operations, educating, and
- 39 training of officials;

- 41 9. *Desires* the implementation of youth programs to promote gender-sensitive education
- 42 to discourage the stigma of inequality;

- 44 10. *Recommends* that Member States promotes the Women's Development Fund aimed at45 supporting the aforementioned women empowerment programs;

- 47 11. Calls upon UN Women to monitor and evaluate the progress of Member States in
- 48 respect to these measures to promote the empowerment of women.
