3 *Recognizing* that modern education, technology, and expertise is critical to global
4 development,

6 *Noting* that “brain-drain” is a major obstacle to developing nations in achieving
7 necessary technical expertise,

9 *Approving* the efforts of those nations which have already established scholarships
10 and educational opportunities for individuals in less privileged counties to build up
11 crucial technical foundations,

13 *Affirming* the positive correlation between strong education and technology
14 foundations and successful sustained development,

16 *Emphasizing* both academic and technical education as precursors to self-reliance,

18 1. *Recommends* teacher training and establishment of education centers in
19 developing nations based on currently existing systems;

21 2. *Encourages* donor nations to establish scholarships to educate individuals both
22 in their own nations and abroad;

24 3. *Draws the attention* of the body to the fact that increased international
25 education with explicit practical applications will promote global development to
26 improve standards of living;

28 4. *Endorses* developing nations to further strengthen their own educational and
29 technical infrastructures;

31 5. *Encourages* the formation of Organization of Professors Without Borders
32 (OPB) with a purpose of sharing technological expertise and best practices for
33 educational improvement through teacher and professor exchange;
