The Economic and Social Council

1 *Alarmed* by the spread of global terrorism and its grave ramifications for the
2 international community,

3
4 *Reaffirming* the commitments undertaken by member states and recalling all
5 aspects of the United Nations Global Counter-Terrorism Strategy, adopted by the General
6 Assembly in its resolution 60/288 of 8 September 2006,

7
8 *Noting* with satisfaction that an increasing number of member states of the United
9 Nations are taking productive steps in counter-terrorism strategies,

10
11 *Stressing* the need for member states to ensure that any measures taken to combat
12 terrorism comply with all their obligations under international law, particularly the
13 Charter of the United Nations and that terrorism in all its forms and manifestations is not
14 to be tolerated ,

16 *Deeply concerned* about continuing acts of terrorism that endanger lives
17 worldwide,

19 1. *Strongly urges* all member states that have not yet done so to ratify all
20 international conventions and protocols against terrorism to assist the international
21 community in unifying against global terrorism;

23 2. *Encourages* all nations with the proper capacity to further assist in financial and
24 technical measures to ensure the halt of global terrorism;

26 3. *Recommends* the Commission on Crimes Prevention and Criminal Justice in
27 coordination with other United Nations institutions, such as the Counter-Terrorism
28 Committee, to regularly review the progress made by member states in becoming parties

29 to and implementing the universal conventions related to terrorism;

31 4. *Calls upon* regional organizations to coordinate their efforts in the fight against
32 terrorism, by ensuring rapid implementation of international treaties and protocols, and
33 supervising effective participation of member parties to combat global terrorism;

35 5. *Recommends* that all nations seek out databases that are already being
36 implemented by regional organizations;

38 6. *Calls for* a biannual symposium with representatives from regional bodies to
39 share information about regional protocols or strategies and their successful
40 implementation;

42 7. *Strongly deplores* terrorism in all its forms and manifestations whether
43 committed by individual or groups of states, and;

45 8. *Expresses* its hope that the international community will have coordinated
46 efforts and unanimity in fighting terrorism.
