## **General Assembly First Committee**

SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Towards an Arms Treaty: Establishing Common International Standards for the Import, Export and Transfer of Conventional Arms SUBMITTED TO: The General Assembly First Committee SUBMITTED BY: Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia The General Assembly Noting that there is still an immense amount of deployed, unexploded, undetonated ordinance throughout the world, Stressing the importance of the location and removal of said explosives to increase public safety, *Understanding* that in warring countries, mines and explosives are often not removed, even after conflicts end. Reaffirming the principles set forth by the Convention on the Prohibition of Use, Transfer, Stockpiling and Production of Anti-Personnel Mines, 1. Calls for the immediate removal and dismantling of any unwanted unexploded ordinance: 2. Encourages developed states, regional powers and organizations to aid developing countries in location and disposal efforts; 3. Requests that the Fifth Committee of the General Assembly create an international fund to help allot resources to defray the costs of removal and destruction of these devices: (a) For training of personnel; (b) To supply the materials and equipment necessary to carry out these operations; 4. Reminds all Member States of their duty to create a safer and more secure world.
