- 33 1. *Strongly encourages* existing regional organizations to take a proactive
34 role in managing conflict amongst their member states and sharing of best
35 practices to promote and maintain peace in the region;
36
- 37 2. *Strongly urges* Member States to make commitments to protect the rights
38 of all residents and foreign nationals in accordance with domestic and
39 international law;
40
- 41 3. *Supports* the adoption of an international declaration by the General
42 Assembly based on the ILC's draft articles, in order to reinforce general principles
43 that must be upheld in all circumstances of nationality in the succession of states;
44
- 45 4. *Urges* the upholding of the principles of state sovereignty, non-
46 discrimination and protection of the familial unit as outlined in the Declaration of
47 Human Rights, and further urges partnership between the UNHCR and regional
48 organizations to uphold these principles;
49
- 50 5. *Suggests* that the UNHCR *further* define their objectives regarding
51 resolving nationality disputes in the succession of states to avoid delays and
52 confusion with regard to assistance such as legal advice, access to resources, and
53 support on the ground;
54
- 55 6. *Recommends* that regional organizations, in order to gain access to
56 UNHCR assistance, are required to have proposals approved by the UNHCR that
57 outline their process of dealing with issues of statelessness;
58
- 59 7. *Encourages* the inclusion of a provision in the protocol allowing stateless
60 individuals that are not accurately represented by their states the option to appeal
61 directly to the UNCHR and/or their regional organization to ensure their right to a
62 nationality is upheld;
63
- 64 8. *Further Encourages* that if a state is not accurately represented by a
65 regional body, the state may appeal directly to the UNHCR to ensure issues of
66 nationality are avoided;
67
- 68 9. *Recommends* that the sharing of best practices extend to discussions
69 between regional organizations to enable outside perspectives to be incorporated;
70
- 71 10. *Strongly suggests* that the UNHCR present a report of their objectives at
72 the 2011 General Assembly session, and have its implementation thereof reviewed
73 at the 2014 General Assembly session;

11. *Calls* for all parties involved to ensure equal treatment of all ethnicities
when dealing with state citizenship during state succession;
