Recalling that one of the primary purposes of the United Nations is to protect universal
human rights as codified by the 1948 Universal Declaration on Human Rights,

Acknowledging the adverse effects of United Nations sanctions on the civilians and economies of sanctioned nations,

Bearing in mind the negative consequences of United Nations sanctions on the economies of nations neighboring sanctioned states,

Noting that civilians of sanctioned nations, civilians of surrounding nations and economies of surrounding nations are recognized as third parties,

1. *Strongly affirms* that regardless of their original intent sanctions that result in violations of human rights are in violation of the Universal Declaration on Human Rights, and by extension, the Charter of United Nations itself;

- 2. Suggests that the International Law Commission evaluate whether or not the human
- 18 rights of third parties have or will be violated by current and/or future sanctions.
