*The Historical Security Council*

- 1 *Reaffirming* Security Council resolutions SC/4, SC/7, SC/9, SC/11, and all other relevant  
2 resolutions,  
3  
4 *Deeply concerned* by the ongoing violence in Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina,  
5  
6 *Noting with regret* that all Council initiatives to date have been less effective than hoped,  
7 *Applauding* the efforts of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization in this situation,  
8  
9 *Expressing* regret at the losses that North Atlantic Treaty Organization troops have  
10 sustained, in particular the significant losses that French troops have sustained,  
11  
12 *Recognizing* the forceful resistance to the North Atlantic Treaty Organization troops near  
13 the airport of Neum,  
14  
15 *Further recognizing* that these United Kingdom troops are acting in conjunction with the  
16 United Nations Protective Force to restore peace and security in the Republic of Bosnia  
17 and Herzegovina in correspondence with resolutions SC/9 and SC/11,  
18  
19 *Further reaffirming* the belief that a negotiated political solution would provide for  
20 lasting peace within the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina,
- 22 1. *Condemns* actions of Croat forces that oppose the aforementioned United  
23 Kingdom Forces in Neum;  
24  
25 2. *Calls* upon Member States to adhere to and recognize the importance of  
26 Presidential Statement 1 of 1 August 1993, and offer any and all available  
27 personnel to secure peace and security in the Republic of Bosnia and  
28 Herzegovina;  
29  
30 3. *Further condemns* forces in Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina who oppose the  
31 efforts of both the United Nations Protection Force as well as the efforts of the North  
32 Atlantic Treaty Organization forces are in violation of Chapter VIII of the

34 United Nations Charter and threatens the goals of the previously adopted  
35 resolutions;  
36  
37 4. *Declares* that if forces in opposition of the goals of the United Nations Security Council  
38 do not concede, the United Nations will be forced to respond with more severe action  
39 on the matter.  
40  
41 5. *Remains* hopeful that forces in opposition of the United Nations in the Republic of  
42 Bosnia and Herzegovina will allow for the possibility of a peaceful end to this conflict  
43 to be reached through diplomatic avenues;  
44  
45 6. *Decides* to send a team of 5 United Nations negotiators to Bosnia in an effort to  
46 facilitate peace negotiations between all parties involved;  
47  
48 7. *Decides further* that this team will be accompanied by a party of 20 United Nations  
49 personnel reallocated from the United Nations Protection Force for their protection;  
50  
51 8. *Urges* the Commission for Peace in Bosnia to find a long-term peace plan with all  
52 expediency possible;  
53  
54 9. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
