- 1 *Recalling* SC/4, SC/7, SC/9, and other relevant resolutions,
2
3 *Concerned* by the recent reports of the Secretary-General regarding the Situation in the
4 State of Bosnia and Herzegovina,
5
6 *Deeply Disturbed* by the violence that continues to pervade throughout the State of
7 Bosnia and Herzegovina,
8
9 *Further Disturbed* by the lack of commitment to peaceful diplomacy by the violent
10 parties within Bosnia,
11
12 *Regretting* the necessity to authorize further force on the part of the United Nations
13 Protection Force within the state of Bosnia in the interest of national security,
14
15 *Hoping* the parties within Bosnia will work towards diffusing the conflict peacefully
16 through dialogue and negotiation in response to the recent actions of the Security
17 Council,

19 1. *Condemns* the violence within the State of Bosnia and Herzegovina;
20
21 2. *Calls upon* the Secretary-General to create a Commission on Peace in Bosnia in order
22 to deliberate upon a suitable peace-plan for the parties involved in the Conflict that would
23 report immediately to the Security Council by 1 September 1993;

25 3. *Demands* that all parties cease hostilities and resume peace talks with all urgency;

27 4. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
