*The Historical Security Council*

- 1           *Reaffirming* its resolutions 745 (1992) of 28 February 1992, 810 (1993) of 8  
2 March 1993, 826 (1993) of 20 May 1993 and other relevant resolutions,  
3  
4           *Welcoming* the success of United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia in  
5 maintaining peace during the elections,  
6  
7           *Applauding* the continuing efforts of His Royal Highness Prince Norodom  
8 Sihanouk, President of the Supreme National Council, in playing a leadership role  
9 in these elections,  
10  
11          *Congratulates* the New Cambodian government on their first meeting,  
12  
13          *Further Congratulates* the efforts of Prince Sihanouk and urges his continued  
14 support in the State,  
15  
16          *Noting* with immense satisfaction the extremely high voting rate within the  
17 election,  
18  
19          *Further Welcoming* the new government into their new positions within the state,  
20  
21          1. *Approves* the report of the Secretary-General;  
22  
23          2. *Reaffirms* the results of the election that has taken place;  
24  
25          3. *Salutes* the efforts of the United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia  
26 that made the extraordinary actions of the Cambodian people possible;  
27  
28          4. *Calls upon* the various parties within Cambodia to respect the results of the  
29 election;

31          5. *Supports* the efforts of Prince Sihanouk to mediate the disputing parties;

33           6. *Requests* that the United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia continue  
34 to work with the Supreme National Council during this period in accordance with the  
35 Paris Agreements;

37           7. *Requests also* the Secretary-General report how the United Nations should act  
38 regarding Cambodia following the end of the United Nations Transitional Authority in  
39 Cambodia's mandate;

41           8. *Urges* all States relevant international organizations continue to actively  
42 contribute to the reconstruction and rehabilitation of Cambodia;

44           9. *Decides* to remain actively seized in the matter.
