Statement by the President of the Security Council

At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 13 July 1993, in connection with the Council's consideration of the items entitled "The Situation in Bosnia" and "The Situation in Somalia" and all peacekeeping operations currently being carried out by the United Nations, the President of the Security Council made the following statement on behalf of the Council:

"The Security Council, in light of the recent resolutions calling for forces in Bosnia and Somalia, requests that all member states contribute any available forces to these important missions which will help to secure peace and stability within the aforementioned regions as well as to aid in halting the extreme violations of the human rights of both civilians in these areas and United Nations forces already in place."

Passed by consensus, with 0 abstentions
