SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Somalia

The Security Council

1 *Recalling* all previous resolutions and statements by its president on Somalia, and
2 particularly its resolutions 733 (1992), 1674 (2006), 1725 (2006), 1744 (2007), 1862 (2009),
3 1907 (2009), 1910 (2010), and 1916 (2010),
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5 *Reaffirming* its respect for the sovereignty of Somalia and its support for the
6 Transitional Federal Government,
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8 *Recognizing* the Transitional Federal Government as the sole legal authority in
9 Somalia,
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11 *Commending* the work of the African Union in Somalia, and in particular the
12 contribution of the African Union Mission to Somalia (AMISOM) to the advancement of
13 peace and stability in Somalia,
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15 *Condemning* the Al-Shaabab and their counterparts for gross violations of human
16 rights and acts of atrocity,
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18 *Acknowledging* that the current size and composition of AMISOM forces is
19 inadequate to fully secure the capital of Mogadishu and surrounding areas,
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21 *Recognizing* the direct relationship between the military strength of the Transitional
22 Federal Government and its ability to perform its governmental tasks,
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24 *Recognizing* the continued serious problem of piracy off the coast of Somalia,
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26 *Stressing* its commitment to the UN Law of the Sea Convention,
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28 *Acting* under Article VII of the UN Charter,
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30 1. *Creates* an African Union/United Nations Hybrid Mission in Somalia (UNAMIS)
31 in support of the Transitional Federal Government which shall include the current resources
32 and personnel of AMISOM and the associated United Nations support packages in Somalia;

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2. *Decides* that the mission of UNAMIS will be comprised of the following:

- (a) To protect the Transitional Federal Government;
- (b) To assist in the training and recruitment of a conventional Somali security force;

3. *Decides* that all UN-mandated naval forces off the coast of Somalia should take action to address sources of income for Somali warlords including but not limited to:

- (a) Toxic waste dumping off the coast of Somalia;
- (b) Illegal fishing in Somali territorial waters;
- (c) Illegal arms imports into Somalia;

4. *Decides* to adopt for the UNAMIS the current mandate of AMISOM and modify it to permit the deployment of up to 13,000 military personnel;

5. *Decides* that the UNAMIS should be fully established with the appropriate logistical and command structures by March 31, 2011;

6. *Calls upon* Member States to contribute the necessary financial and physical equipment for the speedy deployment of the additional military presence authorized by this resolution;

7. *Calls* for the monitoring and reporting of any and all human rights abuses perpetrated by any combatants in Somalia;

8. *Calls upon* Member States to continue to assist in training forces of the Transitional Federal Government so that they may assist the UNAMIS forces in providing security in Somalia at the earliest possible date;

9. *Decides* to exempt the Transitional Federal Government from arms imports restrictions imposed on Somalia by this body;

10. *Requests* that the Secretary-General establish a new status-of-forces agreement for UNAMIS in Somalia in consultation with the Transitional Federal Government of Somalia and the African Union;

11. *Requests* that the Secretary-General prepare a report on the implementation of this resolution in six months time;

10. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
