15	Condemning the Al-Shaabab and their counterparts for gross violations of human

18 19	Acknowledging that the current size and composition of AMISOM forces is
20	inadequate to fully secure the capital of Mogadishu and surrounding areas,
20	Recognizing the direct relationship between the military strength of the Transitional
22	Federal Government and its ability to perform its governmental tasks,

24	Recognizing the continued serious problem of piracy off the coast of Somalia,

30	1. Creates an African Union/United Nations Hybrid Mission in Somalia (UNAMIS)
31	in support of the Transitional Federal Government which shall include the current resources
32	and personnel of AMISOM and the associated United Nations support packages in Somalia;

51	6. Calls upon Member States to contribute the necessary financial and physical
52	equipment for the speedy deployment of the additional military presence authorized by this
53	resolution;

55	7. Calls for the monitoring and reporting of any and all human rights abuses
56	perpetrated by any combatants in Somalia;

58	8. Calls upon Member States to continue to assist in training forces of the
59	Transitional Federal Government so that they may assist the UNAMIS forces in providing
60	security in Somalia at the earliest possible date;
