SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation between Israel and Iran

SUBMITTED TO: The Security Council

The Security Council

- 1 *Gravely* concerned by the damaging events of 30th November, 2010, in the Islamic
2 Republic of Iran, which resulted in loss of civilian life,
3
4 *Condemning* the actions of Israel on the aforementioned event,
5
6 *Further concerned* by the fact that one of the facilities targeted in the attack was a facility
7 previously inspected and approved by the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA),
8
9 *Noting* that, according to Article 2, paragraph 4 of the Charter of the United Nations, “all
10 members shall refrain in their international relations from the threat or use of force
11 against the territorial integrity or political independence of any State, or in any other
12 manner inconsistent with the purposes of the United Nations,”
13
14 *Acknowledging* that the Iranian nuclear facility in Qom existed in violation of relevant
15 Security Council resolutions on compliance with the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of
16 Nuclear Weapons,
17
18 *Acting* under Article VII of the UN Charter,
19
20 1. *Condemns* all past and future violations of Article 2 paragraph 4 of the Charter of the
21 United Nations as previously referenced;

23 2. *Decides* that it is the sole responsibility of the Security Council to take action regarding
24 suspected violations of relevant treaty obligations;
25
26 3. *Demands* that Iran cease all nuclear aid and development in Syria;

28 4. *Requests* that the Secretary General immediately initiate an investigation into all details
29 of the incident on 30th November including the Israeli attack against facilities in the
30 Islamic Republic of Iran and any possible direct provocations for the incident;

32 5. *Urges* both parties to the conflict to refrain from further violent or aggressive actions to
33 allow the Secretary General time to investigate;

35 6. *Strongly urges* that the Islamic Republic of Iran and Israel make all relevant sites and
36 material involved in the 30th November, 2010 incident available to the UN Secretary
37 General's office;

39 7. *Reminds* involved parties of the authority vested in the Security Council under Article
40 41 of Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations to impose sanctions against States
41 which threaten international security;

43 8. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
