*The Security Council*

- 1       *Recognizing* the joint efforts between Haiti and the UN Member States,  
2  
3       *Deeply concerned* with the current humanitarian crisis occurring in Haiti,  
4  
5       *Alarmed by* the recent spread of cholera throughout the country,  
6  
7       *Expressing concern* over the recent riots and disturbance at elections centers and  
8 other parts of the country,  
9  
10       *Reaffirming* our commitment and obligation to the nation of Haiti in its time of  
11 crisis,  
12  
13       *Acting* under Chapter 7 of the UN Charter,  
14  
15       1. *Calls on* Member States to fulfill all their obligations to the nation of Haiti for  
16 the purposes of development and humanitarian aid;  
17  
18       2. *Strongly urges* all Member States to fulfill their monetary commitments to  
19 Haiti;

21       3. *Recommends* Member States to forgive all outstanding debts of Haiti if they  
22 have not already done so;

24       4. *Strongly encourages* the implementation of a screening mechanism for all  
25 peacekeepers, and any future peacekeepers sent to all countries, to test for diseases and  
26 calls upon relevant bodies to review policies and procedures for future medical testing of  
27 peacekeepers;

29       5. *Calls for* the removal of all peacekeepers that have been identified as carrying  
30 cholera in Haiti;

32           6. *Calls upon* all relevant bodies of the United Nations such as the United Nations  
33 High Commission on Refugees and World Food Program to increase their aid efforts in  
34 Haiti;

36           7. *Encourages* the continued support from Non-Governmental Organizations  
37 (NGOs) and requests that they increase humanitarian aid and European Union Election  
38 Monitors;

40           8. *Calls upon* the office of the Secretary General to monitor the ongoing situation  
41 in Haiti and to work with NGO's in improving distribution methods and humanitarian aid  
42 efforts.

Passed by consensus, with 0 abstentions
