SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Consolidation of peace through practical
disarmament measures

SUBMITTED TO: The General Assembly Plenary

The General Assembly Plenary,

- 1 *Recognizing* the proliferation of anti-personnel landmines in post-conflict countries,
2
3 *Emphasizing* the indiscriminate and anonymous violence landmines cause to civilians
4 on a daily basis,
5
6 *Bearing in mind* the need for the international community to fully recognize the
7 problematic nature of landmines and need for cooperation in both de-mining and ceasing
8 future use of landmines,
9
10 *Noting with deep concern* that debilitating societal effects of landmines, including
11 preventing access to medical facilities, clean water, and schools for civilians, causing
12 structural problems, poses a permanent threat to international security.
- 14 1. *Affirms* existing international organs and treaties that deal with anti-personnel
15 landmines including the Ottawa Treaty, United Nations Office for Project Services, and all
16 other relevant institutions;

18 2. *Recommends* a survey and prioritization of countries where landmine violence is
19 most pervasive;

21 3. *Calls upon* Member States and relevant non-State actors to disseminate both
22 disarming technology and medical assistance, deferring to Economic and Social Council for
23 their funding, to countries affected by landmines including:
24 (a) Training of landmine removal personnel and education of communities on
25 landmine zones and safety precautions;
26 (b) Adequate psychological and physical treatment to landmine victims with respect
27 to their reintegration into society;

29 4. *Requests* that each State that manufactures landmines implement a tracing program
30 and a numerical tagging system for monitoring usage;

32 5. *Urges* the consideration of societal effects of landmines in future comprehensive
33 solutions;

35 6. *Discourages* the production and transport of landmines among Member States.
