SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: HSC-1973 Situation in the Middle East

The Historical Security Council

1 *Reminding* all states that the tragic incident of the commercial Libyan airline is
2 not merely a sporadic incident,
3

4 *Bearing* in mind it is a continuation of the ongoing conflict between the Arabs and
5 the Israelis and,
6

7 *Acknowledging* the continuing conflict in the Sinai Peninsula,
8

9 *Realizing* that a short-term solution will not be able to achieve lasting peace in a
10 volatile region,
11

12 *Stressing* the complex situation at hand and the need for the world community to
13 pursue a path towards a lasting peace that will deter such incidents from occurring again,
14

15 *Declaring* the need for a viable solution and effective vehicle to provide security
16 to all parties, thus allowing for the stabilization of the region,
17

18 *Taking into account* 5/RES/242 that requires the removal of Israeli forces from the
19 Sinai Peninsula,
20

21 1. *Invites* Israel and the Arab League to engage in dialogue with the occupation of
22 the Sinai Peninsula being of utmost importance and priority;

24 2. *Designates* the USA, USSR, China, France and UK to facilitate the dialogue;

26 3. *Requests* the dialogue lead to a comprehensive peace process;
27

28 4. *Urges* Member States to comply with the proposed solution to the current
29 crisis;
30

31 5. *Stresses* the importance of dialogue and compromise to attain a lasting peace;
32

33 6. *Recommends* a revolving dialogue be initiated within three (3) months hosted
34 by the Arab League, and continue every three (3) months until all outstanding issues are
35 resolved;

37 7. *Emphasizes* that this long-term resolution addresses the latest developments in
38 the Middle East.

40 8. *Encourages* a decision or compromise be made by 31 December 1973 on the
41 topic of the occupied Sinai Peninsula or the Security Council will begin to consider
42 possible sanctions or actions to resolve the issue in order to prevent further destabilization
43 of the region.
