SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: HSC-1973 The Situation in Cyprus

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council

The Historical Security Council

1 *Mindful* of the historic divisions between Greek and Turkish Cypriot citizens,
2

3 *Saddened* by the unstable violence between the divided communities of the newly
4 established Cypriot nation,
5

6 *Urging* the Security Council to aid Cyprus in finding a viable solution to the
7 contentious issues in which the two communities are involved,
8

9 *Supporting* the continuation of the ongoing peace talks between the nations of
10 Cyprus, Turkey, Greece and the UK,
11

12 *Bearing in mind* that the current mandate is close to expiration, and understanding
13 the necessity of extending the United Nations Force In Cyprus (UNFICYP) mandate for
14 one year as there has been no closure regarding this mission with the option for renewal
15 at the conclusion of that year,
16

17 *Noting with concern* the need for the creation of an official ceasefire line between
18 the Greek and Turkish Cypriot citizens,
19

20 *Further noting* the need for the creation of a buffer zone to alleviate tension in
21 Cyprus as dictated by the command of UNFICYP,
22

23 1. *Recommends* the buffer zone to extend along ceasefire zone in order to prevent
24 and cease further outbreaks of violence;

26 2. *Also recommends* that the created buffer zone should vary in size in accordance
27 with need;
28

29 3. *Acknowledges* that the Cypriot capital is divided and a return to normal
30 conditions can be facilitated by a narrower buffer zone within the capital;

32 4. *Authorizes* UNFICYP peacekeepers to conduct regulatory duties between the
33 communities separated by the buffer zone;
34

35 5. *Extends* the extension of the UNFICYP mandate for another year.

37 6. *Requests* that the number of peacekeeping forces in Cyprus be increased by
38 1,200 and capped at that level

40 7. *Designates* that the forces be made up of forces that have been pledged by the
41 nations of Austria, USSR and USA in the following amounts: 200 more from Austria, 500
42 from USA and 500 from USSR

44 8. *Endorses* the addition of Indonesia to the ongoing peace talks.
