SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: HSC-1973 The Situation in Southern Rhodesia

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council

*The Historical Security Council*

1        *Citing* the Report to the Security Council on: Special Report Mission to Zambia to  
2 Investigate the Continued Violence in Southern Rhodesia,

3  
4        *In accordance* with the recommendation in paragraph five (5) of the above  
5 referenced document,

6  
7        *Reminding* all states of the ongoing hostility on the southern border of Zambia,

8  
9        *Also reminding* all states of the reports reference to those that disregard the UN  
10 sanctions in violation of the UN charter,

11  
12        *Recognizing* the request for military assistance addressed to the Security Council  
13 by the Representative of the Republic of Zambia,

14  
15        1. *Decides* to authorize the Secretary-General to take the necessary steps, in  
16 consultation with the government of Zambia, to provide their government with such  
17 peacekeeping assistance, as may be necessary, through the efforts of the Zambian  
18 Government with the technical assistance of the United Nations, until the national  
19 security forces may be able to meet fully their tasks of providing peace along the border;

20  
21        2. *Requests* the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council as appropriate;

22  
23        3. *Recommends* for a coalition of United Nations peacekeeping forces to be  
24 formed, consisting of peacekeepers with small arms; consisting of 1,000 or less troops  
25 from the states of Peru, Australia, Indonesia, Russia and any other willing United Nations  
26 member state;

27  
28        4. *Emphasizing* that the duration of the peacekeeping mission lasts no longer than  
29 six (6) consecutive months from the time of deployment unless further approval by the  
30 Security Council and the government of Zambia occurs.

31  
32        5. *Strongly encourages* the participation of African states in order to benefit long-  
33 term security in the region;

35        6. *Expressing* its appreciation for the pledged support of troops and aid by Guinea  
36 and Kenya;

38           7. *Further expressing* it's appreciation for the pledged support of equal numbers  
39 of military commanders by the USSR and USA;

41           8. *Designates* the creation of a buffer zone along the Zambizi River.
