Acknowledging that the conflict in Iraq effectively suspended several 1 humanitarian aid programs, such as Oil-for-Food among others, 2 3 4 Believing that all people have basic human rights and that when these rights are neglected or infringed upon, humanitarian aid should be used in order to address these 5 rights regardless of their economic, political or social status within the global community, 8 *Recognizing* that the cessation of these aforementioned programs could cause a 9 humanitarian crisis of untold proportions and severity, 10 *Fearing* that any delay within the United Nations as a body in immediate 11 12 humanitarian action could have grave impacts on the population of Iraq, 13 14

- 1. *Calls for* the creation of the United Nations Mission in Iraq (UNMI);
- 2. *Invites* member states to contribute to their respective ability for an impartial United Nations security force that will protect humanitarian workers who are delivering humanitarian aid to the people of Iraq including, but not limited to food, water, shelter, medical supplies and other basic necessities;
 - 3. *Also decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
