Recognizing that all Member States have sovereignty under Article 2.1 in the Charter of the United Nations.

Realizing that the instability in Somalia has lead to an increase in Somali-based piracy targeting international shipping lanes,

Fully Aware of the detrimental effect piracy has on the economies of those affected by it,

Affirming the resolutions passed by the Security Council concerning the situation in Somalia, especially resolutions 1918 (2010), 1950 (2010), 1972 (2011), and 1976 (2011),

Recognizing that these previous efforts have been insufficient to curb piracy in a significant manner,

1. Supports the use of commercial ships carrying private armed security forces to ensure their personal safety;

2. *Recommends* that a regional facility be built to detain those suspected of piracy until the International Criminal Court (ICC) can try them, whereupon they will be transferred to a permanent facility if found guilty;

3. Calls upon Member States to coordinate naval military efforts to combat and prosecute piracy and maritime terrorism within international waters;

4. Further recommends that all nations operating in this endeavor coordinate with UN peacekeeping forces in order to promote a just and peaceful resolution;

5. *Decides* to remain actively seized on the matter.
