SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in Somalia

The Security Council

1 *Affirming* the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Somalia and neighboring
2 Member States,

3
4 *Taking into account* present instability which has ravaged Somalia since 1991,

5
6 *Noting* the Report of the Secretary-General on Somalia, S/2011/549, and the
7 Report of the Secretary-General on the protection of Somali natural resources and waters,
8 S/2011/661,

9
10 *Reaffirming* Security Council Resolution S/Res/1976 (2011), which recognizes the
11 instability in Somalia as a crucial reason for the piracy occurring in the waters to the East
12 of the Gulf of Aden,

13
14 *Commending* the African Union for its efforts to stabilize Somalia in the African
15 Union Mission in Somalia since its deployment in 2007,

16
17 *Taking into account* the limits of the African Union Mission in Somalia under
18 current United Nations mandates due to the lack of resources,

19
20 *Noting with concern* current cross-border fighting between non-state actors in
21 Somalia and the neighboring Member States of Ethiopia and Kenya, as well as the
22 ongoing instability of the region constituting the aforementioned countries,

23
24 *Acknowledging* current African Union difficulties in regards to resources and
25 authority in most parts of Africa,

26
27 1. *Encourages* greater multilateral cooperation between Ethiopia, Kenya, and
28 Somalia in combating forces of instability in the region;

30 2. *Urges* Ethiopia to work with the African Union in its efforts to stabilize
31 Somalia and the African Horn region;

33 3. *Pledges* increased humanitarian aid to the African Union Mission in Somalia to
34 support efforts in ending hunger;

36 4. *Requests* greater military commitment for the African Union Mission in

37 Somalia by:

38 (a) The African Union expanding its peacekeeping commitment up to 20,000
39 peacekeepers, expand its scope beyond the city of Mogadishu, and to maintain the
40 stability of international frontiers;

41 (b) Member States providing logistical and material support;

42 (c) Member States sending military advisors to train and support the training of
43 security forces in Somalia.
