SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in Iran

SUBMITTED TO: The Security Council

1 *Affirming* relevant Security Council resolutions on the matter, including
2 Resolutions 1929 (2010), 1835 (2008), 1803 (2008), 1747 (2007), 1737 (2006), and 1696
3 (2006),
4

5 *Recalling* the report of the Director General of the International Atomic Energy
6 Agency (IAEA) on 8 November 2011,
7

8 *Noting* the resolutions that the Board of Governors of the IAEA have adopted
9 between 2003 and 2009, as well as the most recent resolution adopted on 18 November
10 2011,
11

12 *Further recalling* the Agreement between Iran and the Agency for the Application
13 of Safeguards in Connection with the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear
14 Weapons of 15 May 1974,
15

16 *Bearing in mind* the agreement between the IAEA and the United Nations
17 Security Council in maintaining international peace and security, established on 14
18 November 1957,

20 *Noting with concern* the lack of transparency interpreted by the international
21 community and displayed by the Islamic Republic of Iran,
22

23 *Considering* the cultural shift from hardline policy to a desire for diplomatic
24 solutions in the international community,
25

26 *Further considering* the recent willingness of Iran to be more transparent towards
27 the IAEA,
28

29 1. *Applauds* Iranian cooperation with IAEA observation and encourages more
30 proactive cooperation in the future;

32 2. *Demands* full transparency and compliance with the Non-Proliferation Treaty
33 (NPT) and the IAEA Safeguards Agreements with respect to the specified sites that the
34 IAEA has deemed pertinent for inspection, on the part of the Islamic Republic of Iran,
35 dependent upon the following incentives:

36 a. If Iran does not become fully compliant as per IAEA standards by 20 January
37 2012 at 00:00 GMT, sanction status will return to status quo of 21 November 2011;

38 b. If Iran becomes fully compliant by aforementioned date, the United States will
39 reduce sanctions upon Iran;

40 c. The United Nations Security Council will also reduce its sanctions against Iran;

42 3. *Encourages* discussions between Iran and the international community,
43 especially the IAEA, on advanced ways of producing peaceful nuclear energy without a
44 focus on higher-enriched uranium being a necessity;

46 4. *Promotes, with neutral cooperation* from the international community, a green
47 energy initiative allowing Iran to ease its need of non-renewable resources.
