SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: International cooperation on humanitarian assistance in the field of natural disasters, from relief to development

SUBMITTED TO: The General Assembly Plenary (Concurrent)

The General Assembly Plenary (Concurrent),

With respect to the sovereignty of all nations and with no intentions to infringe upon that sovereignty,

Reaffirming the Hyogo Declaration and Framework for Action of 2005,

Mindful of the pressing need for the international community to provide aid and relief to the countries ravaged by natural disasters,

Aware of the need to effectively administer, manage, and finance international relief and development efforts,

Stressing the need for advancing education of the local populace of effected states to lessen the severity of future crisis within that nation,

Recognizing the efforts of the Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) to coordinate with Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) a stable process for the movement from short-term assistance to medium-term recovery and long-term development,

Emphasizing the importance of and continued participation in, and donation to, the Central Emergency Relief Fund by Member States,

- 1. Recommends to the Secretary-General the creation of an Office of Disaster Integrated Specialist Coordination (DISC) operating within OCHA and aimed at increasing efficiency of relief efforts by coordinating the reconstruction and sustainable development phase as well as limiting fraud, waste, and abuse that is currently a reality and that:
 - (a) DISC serves as the facilitator of relief and reconstruction efforts under the authority of OCHA from whom DISC will request budgetary appropriation to be drawn from the Central Emergency Response Fund (CERF) for the purposes of employment and deployment of responding NGOs;
 - (b) DISC specialists compile an official roster of available NGOs, focusing on

- ability to respond, availability of proper resources, and task specialization, from which relief contracts will be generated;
- 36 (c) DISC requires all NGOs participating to hire a minimum of 10% of their workforce from the local population of the state effected by a natural disaster in collaboration with the state when possible;
 - (d) An annual audit and report, generated by DISC, be delivered to OCHA and the United Nations General Assembly in oversight of all budgetary concerns and on the status of response efforts;
 - (e) An audit be completed and returned to DISC by the NGOs after the completion of crisis response and redevelopment;
