	SUBMITTED TO:	The General Assembly Second Committee
	The General Assembly Second Committee,  Alarmed by the lack of suitable farmland for sustained development in developing nations and bearing in mind the need for sustainable farming,  Calls upon member states to participate in a global scale geographic analysis of land to better understand the most effective agricultural land use,  Approves of the assistance provided for small farmers,  Draws attention to the potential usage of farm land for increased food security for states or for bio-fuel productions depending on member states' wants and needs,  Further reminding states of their duties to the millennium development goals to eradicate poverty and hunger and to Article 25 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights which states that everyone has the "right to a standard of living adequate for the health and well-being of himself and his family",  1. Requests that the United Nation Research Institute for Social Development consider adding to its 2013 research topics:  (a) A comprehensive environmental development analysis, including research or geographical and climatological impacts on agriculture worldwide;  (b) Current agricultural techniques and technology and their impact on the land;	
	2. Supports providing further specific vocational education on specific crop growth
