SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Protection of the human rights of civilians in armed conflict

SUBMITTED TO: The Human Rights Council

The Human Rights Council,

1 *Recognizing* that special consideration should be taken in advance with regards to the
2 needs of women in armed conflicts, specifically the needs of childcare services and
3 medical attention as a result of sexual violence and emotional counseling,
4

5 *Understanding* states' rights and sovereignty in regards to such a program,
6

7 *Emphasizing* that such programs are on a voluntary basis, including the possibility of
8 the state omitting parts of the program with which it may have a cultural disagreement;
9

10 1) *Recommends* the Medical Assistance Consideration Program (MACP), which will
11 consist of the following parts that all have the possibility of omission with regards to each
12 other during implementation:

13 (a) Childcare services which include child daycare provision, as well as nutrition
14 counseling will be the primary objectives of such services;

15 (b) Medical attention as a result of sexual violence, including premeditated provision
16 of antibiotics and gynecological care to affected women through resource and qualified
17 personnel provision;

18 (c) Emotional counseling, as those affected by sexual violence benefit from the
19 provision of support groups and psychologically qualified personnel to conduct
20 assessments and recommendations;

22 2) *Encourages* the recruitment of voluntary and commissioned medical professionals,
23 both regionally and upon need, branching out to further areas as necessary.
