- 1 *Acknowledging* the conflict in the region Jammu and Kashmir,

- 3 *Striving* to bring appropriate and lasting peace to the region,

- 5 *Anticipating* the future advisory opinion from the ICJ,
- 6
- 7 *Endorsing* the following sections of the UN Charter: Article 1 Section 2 and Article 1
- 8 Section 3,
- 9
- 10 *Recognizing* the importance and necessity of practicing religious tolerance,
- 11
- 12 1. *Condemns* the violence that is taking place in the Jammu and Kashmir region;
- 13
- 14 2. *Demands* a ceasefire take place between all parties involved;
- 15
- 16 3. *Strongly suggests* the implementation of peace talks after the Security Council
- 17 hears from the ICJ to bring Pakistan and India together, under the following guidelines:
- 18 (a) Advise that the meeting be held in Ottawa, with Canada, Ukrainian Soviet
- 19 Socialist Republic, China and United Kingdom overseeing the progression of the
- 20 talks;
- 21 (b) Further call the nations to discuss:
- 22 (i) Process of self-determination via fair and free elections;
- 23 (ii) Peaceful transition based on the will of the people;
- 24 (iii) Border security;
- 25 (iv) Restriction of arms traveling to the region.
