SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Namibia

The Historical Security Council – 1990,

- 1 *Affirming* Resolution I/I as passed by this body,
2
3 *Alarmed by* the South African occupation of the sovereign state of Namibia,
4
5 *Emphasizing* UN recognition of an independent Namibian state,
6
7 *Recognizing* that South Africa views external military presence as a threat to their
8 nation,
9
10 *Realizing* the need for Cuban troops to withdraw above the 13th parallel as per the
11 New York Accords,
12
13 *Deeply regretting* the escalating conflict in Sub-Saharan Africa,
- 15 1. *Emphasizes* the sentiments expressed by the UN Security Council in the recent
16 press conference regarding South Africa;

18 2. *Calls upon* all parties involved to continue to implement the framework outlined in
19 the New York Accords;

21 3. *Demands* the immediate cessation of all troop movements by South Africa within
22 the sovereign state of Namibia as verified by UN Observers;

24 4. *Further Demands* Cuban troops in Angola to retreat north of the 13th parallel
25 following the aforementioned cessation of South African troop movement as verified by
26 the UNSC;

28 5. *Further demands* the recognition of the Namibian state by South Africa and
29 the overseen withdrawal of South Africa from its positions in Namibia by UN
30 observers immediately;

32 6. *Urges* all involved parties to halt their military escalation in the area;

34 7. *Recommends* that if the aforementioned parties do not uphold these terms, further

35 disciplinary action will be taken immediately;

37 8. *Add and further requests* a report from the Secretary General on the situation.
