SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Indochina

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council -- 1990

The Historical Security Council – 1990,

1 *Reaffirming* its resolutions 35/6 of October 1980, 43/19 of November 1988, and
2 44/22 of November 1989,

3
4 *Noting with concern* that the self-determination of the Kampuchean people continues
5 to be hindered by the lack of a capable government,

6
7 *Encouraged* by the willingness of all involved parties to meet with each other
8 diplomatically in order to solve the Indochinese crisis,

9
10 *Expressing its concern* that the conflict in Kampuchea threatens the sovereignty of
11 Thailand,

12
13 *Affirming* UN donor countries for their continued support of affected displaced
14 peoples of the region,

15
16 *Alarmed* by the increased deployment of foreign forces on the borders of
17 Kampuchea, serving as a catalyst for further human rights violations,

18
19 1. *Appeals* to all member nations to offer aid to Kampuchean refugees and assist
20 them in repatriating at the earliest safe opportunity;

21
22 2. *Calls upon* the People's Republic of Kampuchea and the Coalition Government of
23 Democratic Kampuchea to establish a unified government with all appropriate speed;

24
25 3. *Urges* Vietnamese forces to withdraw from Kampuchea with all haste;

26
27 4. *Encourages* the GA Third Committee, Social and Humanitarian, to consider the
28 situation of human trafficking that has thrived due to the border conflicts as well as lack
29 of security surrounding refugee camps;

31 5. *Establishes* a United Nations Security Council observer group in Kampuchea to
32 oversee the establishment of a unified government, in accord with the wishes of both
33 parties and to investigate the reports of foreign troops on Kampuchean soil, to ensure that
34 all parties abide by their previous agreements.
