SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Syria

SUBMITTED TO: The Security Council

The Security Council,

- 1 *Noting with alarm* the continued conflict in Syria and the increasing amount of
2 civilian deaths,
3
4 *Expressing* regret over the failure of past ceasefire agreements,
5
6 *Reiterating* that the sovereignty of Syria is ultimately determined by the will of its
7 citizens,
8
9 *Recalling* Security Council Resolutions 2042 and 2043,
10
11 *Concerned* by the targeting of UN vehicles from Syrian forces,
12
13 1. *Condemns* not only actions of the Assad Government against peaceful
14 protestors, but also deplorable actions committed by opposition groups including torture,
15 beating, and indiscriminate killing;

17 2. *Deplores* the use of indiscriminate shelling on population centers which has
18 caused the death of innocent civilians;

20 3. *Calls for* an immediate ceasefire imposed upon both sides of the conflict and a
21 return to the principles laid out in the Six Point Plan and in SC resolutions 2042 and
22 2043;

24 5. *Condemns* the seizure of territory in the cross-border buffer zone by rebel
25 forces;

27 6. *Requests* the cessation of all fighting in these cross-border buffer zones in
28 keeping with the bilateral agreements that established them;

30 7. *Decides* that, in keeping with the spirit and intent of the Kofi Annan Peace
31 Plan, Syria begin an inclusive, democratic, Syrian-led, monitored political transition to

32 address the legitimate aspirations of the Syrian people;

34 8. *Further decides* that in the aforementioned transition, all Syrian Nationals
35 granted equal voting rights and participation regardless of their affiliations, ethnicities, or
36 beliefs;

38 9. *Demands* that the opposition renounce all ties with terrorist and Islamist
39 groups as a precondition to further dialogue with the international community;

41 10. *Further requests* that the aforementioned opposition groups establish a
42 dialogue with the Assad Government with the goal of achieving peace based on Kofi
43 Annan's Six Point Plan;

45 11. *Urges* nations neutral to the Syrian conflict to host this conference;

47 12. *Establishes* that this conference should include discussion regarding possible
48 constitutional revisions;

50 13. *Asks* representatives from relevant ethnic groups, such as Alawites and
51 Kurds, to meet in a similar fashion to the opposition in an effort to develop solutions to
52 increasing sectarian tensions;

53

54 14. *Reauthorizes* the mandate of the United Nations Supervision Mission in
55 Syria (UNSMIS) for 6 months, with the following features:

56

(a) The mission will become a military observatory mission, who may only
57 use force for the purpose of self-defense;

58

(b) The mission will act as a fact-finder to ensure that the principles of the
59 Six Point Plan are being carried out by both sides, and report these findings
60 to the Security Council;

61

(c) The mission will attempt to establish a mechanism to facilitate the
62 demilitarization of individual cities, involving withdrawal of both
63 the Syrian government and rebel forces;

64

65 15. *Deplores* any and all attacks on humanitarian missions in Syria;

66

67 16. *Demands* that humanitarian missions and journalists are given unfettered
68 access to the country in keeping with the Six Point Plan;

69

70 17. *Requests* that funding for the winterization of the United Nations High
71 commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) mission in Syria to be increased to \$75 million in
72 keeping with their recommendations;

74 18. *Decides* to remain actively seized in this matter.
