SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in Syria

SUBMITTED TO: The Security Council

*The Security Council*

1        *Noting* with alarm the violence and increased civilian casualties occurring in Syria,

2

3        *Recognizing* that the crisis in Syria can spread to the countries surrounding it,

4

5        *Reiterating* the United Nations duty to ensure the safety of all people,

6

7        *Recalling* the previous resolutions 2042 and 2043 in view of the failure to provide  
8 humanitarian support to the Syrian people,

9

10        1. *Calls* on nations surrounding Syria to maintain a close watch on its borders and  
11 airspace to ensure weapons do not leave Syria, especially heavy weapons, combat  
12 vehicles, and chemical weapons;

13

14        2. *Encourages* those nations to ask assistance from United Nations if they feel they  
15 cannot keep weapons from leaving Syria;

16

17        3. *Asks* for increased aid from member states to refugee camps in surrounding nations  
18 that support Syrian refugees so they can properly supply them with the basic necessities  
19 that all human beings should have;

20

21        4. *Calls* on the United Nations high commissioner for refugees (UNHCR) to  
22 appropriate funds based purely on the amount of refugees in need, regardless of where  
23 their sympathies lie;

25        5. *Calls* on UNHCR to closely monitor the use of appropriated funds to prevent them  
26 from being used for anything other than aiding refugees;

27

28        6. *Requests* that funding for the winterization of the UNHCR mission in Syria to be  
29 increased to 75 million in keeping with their recommendations;

31        7. *Further requests* that member nations contribute to the technological capacity of  
32 the UNHCR to facilitate the registration of refugees entering the camps;

34        8. *Calls* for the prompt drafting of a preliminary budget by member nations outlining

36 how the Syria Humanitarian Assistance Response Plan (SHARP) and the Regional  
37 Refugee Plan created by the UNHCR will be funded in full in the immediate future;

39 9.*Asks* bordering nations to step up border security in the interest of preventing  
40 radical groups, using the outpouring of refugees as a cover, from infiltrating their nations;

42 10.*Notes* that bordering nations are welcome to ask the Security Council members for  
43 logistical support in accomplishing the above objective;

45 11.*Requests* for other nations to consider taking on Syrian refugees in order to help  
46 alleviate the burden that nations such as Turkey and Lebanon are experiencing with  
47 housing and supplying the refugees;

49 12.*Encourages* all relevant bodies in the United Nations to focus their attention on  
50 this issue and lend all feasible assistance;

52 14.*Calls* all sides to cease any action that violates any established buffer zones with  
53 neighboring countries including the Golan Heights;

55 15.*Decides* to remain actively involved in the matter.
