- 5 such rights,

- 7 *Expressing* the necessity of modernizing existing treaties regarding the international
- 8 usage of space by member states,

- 10 1. *Calls for* the modernization of existing United Nations treaties to reflect updates in
- 11 space technology, with specific emphasis on:
- 12 (a) Ensuring the future access of resources in outer space for developing member states;
- 13 (b) Ensuring that private organizations and corporations are properly governed and
- 14 regulated;
- 15 (c) Ensuring international collaboration between developed and developing member
- 16 states, including the sharing of pertinent data and technology that member states could
- 17 use to advance their own space programs in a peaceful manner;
- 18 (d) Ensuring the multilateral nature of world diplomacy is reflected in the governing
- 19 documents regarding member states' involvement in outer space;
- 20 (e) Ensuring outer space remains free from conventional and nuclear weapons.
