SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: International cooperation in the peaceful uses of outer space

SUBMITTED TO: The General Assembly Fourth Committee

The General Assembly Fourth Committee,

Recognizing that the goal of the international community is to pursue space development
that improves the condition of all human kind,

*Understanding* that the United Nations International Telecommunications Union (ITU) designates both orbital and electromagnetic spectrum positions for space satellites,

Acknowledging that space-based solar power can improve conditions for both developing and developed countries by providing the opportunity to generate abundant, non-stop, low-emissions, low-waste energy,

1. *Recognizes* that the ITU has sole jurisdiction over the designation of orbital and electromagnetic spectrum positions for space-based solar power platforms;

- 2. *Requests* that the ITU consider reserving orbital and electromagnetic spectrum positions for space-based solar power platform proposals that meet the following conditions:
- (a) The proposal is sponsored by at least three member states including at least one third Less Developed Countries;
- (b) The proposal makes use of launch vehicles propelled by liquid hydrogen, liquid nitrogen, or other low-emissions fuels or space elevators.
