SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: International cooperation in the peaceful uses of  
outer space

*The General Assembly Fourth Committee,*

1 *Recognizing* that the goal of the international community is to pursue space development  
2 that improves the condition of all human kind,  
3

4 *Understanding* that the United Nations International Telecommunications Union (ITU)  
5 designates both orbital and electromagnetic spectrum positions for space satellites,  
6

7 *Acknowledging* that space-based solar power can improve conditions for both developing  
8 and developed countries by providing the opportunity to generate abundant, non-stop,  
9 low-emissions, low-waste energy,  
10

11 1. *Recognizes* that the ITU has sole jurisdiction over the designation of orbital and  
12 electromagnetic spectrum positions for space-based solar power platforms;  
13

14 2. *Requests* that the ITU consider reserving orbital and electromagnetic spectrum  
15 positions for space-based solar power platform proposals that meet the following  
16 conditions:

17 (a) The proposal is sponsored by at least three member states including at least  
18 one third Less Developed Countries;

19 (b) The proposal makes use of launch vehicles propelled by liquid hydrogen,  
20 liquid nitrogen, or other low-emissions fuels or space elevators.
