SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Extending the Haitian mandate

The Historical Security Council -- 1994

- 1 *Recalling* Resolution 867 (1993) and all other relevant resolutions,
2
3 *Deeply concerned* by the currently escalating situation in Haiti,
4
5 *Noting* the importance of national sovereignty in Haiti and all nations,
6
7 *Desiring* the prompt restoration of democratic institutions in Haiti,
8
9 1. *Authorizes* the extension of the United Nations Mission in Haiti with the
10 following updates:
11 (a) *Approves* the implementation of the 4-Part Peace Plan Proposal as developed
12 by the Haitian Parliament in place of the Governors Island Agreement and the political
13 accords contained in the New York Pact;
14 (b) *Calls upon* democratically elected President Aristide's return shall be set for
15 six months from the date of the adoption of this resolution, being 1 October 1994;
16 (c) *Calls upon* democratically elected President Aristide shall announce a new
17 prime minister nominee to head a coalition government within six months time;
18 (d) *Refrains from* relaxing the arms embargo on Haiti until above requests are
19 met;
20
21 2. *Further recommends* placing five United Nations observers in Haiti to monitor
22 the implementation of the above revised 4-Part Peace Plan Proposal;

24 3. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
