The Historical Security Council -- 1994

Reaffirming its resolution 814 of 26 March 1993 and all subsequent resolutions relating to the United Nations Operation in Somali II,

Noting with appreciation the important role that regional cooperation has played in addressing the conflict in Somalia so far while recognizing how this involvement can be fundamental in the settling of political instability in the country,

Noting with regret and deeply disturbed by the 300,000 deaths of Somali Citizens due to drought and starvation,

Having considered the updates of the Secretary-General on the Situation in Somalia,

1. Condemns continued violence and civil war throughout Somalia;

2. Further condemns attacks by armed factions in Somalia against UNISOM II operations and personnel;

3. *Calls for* all parties in Somalia to recognize and abide by the signing of the Addis Ababa Agreement of March 1993;

4. *Encourages* the parties of the conflict to be committed to the achievement of peace, bearing in mind that this commitment is necessary in order for any UN involvement to continue and be effective;

5. *Urges* that the UNISOM II Mandate be extended with specific emphasis on humanitarian aide, protecting UN and NGO operations and personnel;

6. Further urges that the remaining UN Peacekeeping forces of UNISOM II continue to receive the necessary funding to maintain an effective position with an increase in funds to make-up for the void in defense of UN and NGO personnel/operations by the evacuating United States forces

7. Calls upon NGOs such as the Red Cross, Doctors Without Borders, the World Health Organization, and other medical assistance organizations to address the cholera outbreak in Somalia.
