SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in the Central African Republic

Deeply concerned with the recent events that occurred in the Central African Republic,

Noting the difficulties of the implementation of Mission in the Central African Republic (MICAR) and United Nations Missions for the Verification of Human Rights in the Central African Republic (MINUCAR) in the Central African Republic,

Stressing the importance of ensuring the safety of all civilians of the Central African Republic in this time of great conflict,

Acknowledging the need to identify and address the root causes of the insurgencies in the Central African Republic and allow individuals that have or might turn to insurgent groups to be integrated peacefully into the political process in the Central African Republic as a means to address grievances,

Condemning the human rights violations committed by various rebel factions within the Central African Republic, specifically the recent murders of the Pakistani and French personnel,

Keeping in mind that the conflict in the Central African Republic, if left unaddressed, poses a threat to the stability of the region,

 1. *Requests* the MICAR and International Support Mission in the Central African Republic deepen their cooperation in addressing the instability in the Central African Republic with the MICAR drawing upon the expertise of the African Union - led MISCA;

2. Authorizes a 3,000 person task force to engage in offensive actions against militia groups committing atrocities in Central African Republic, by reallocating members of the current MICAR;

3. *Urges* the government of the Central African Republic to recognize and abide by international human rights agreements, such as the Universal Declaration of Human Rights;

4. Strongly recommends the expansion of training programs for Central African

40 Republic law enforcement officers, led by the Russian Federation and the United States of America, with the goal of expanding the state capacity to ensure the security of its 41 42 population; 43 44 5. Encourages collaboration with local populations as well as information 45 gathering in order to learn and explore the underlining issues in the conflict in the Central African Republic as well as the motivations of the various rebel factions in order to better 46 47 achieve the goals of the MICAR; 48 49 6 Further requests the allocation of previously pledged funds from Australia and 50 Luxembourg through the MICAR be directed toward the purchase and distribution of 51 (a) Bullet proof vests; 52 (b) Navigation equipment; 53 (c) Advanced communications equipment; 54 55 7. Accepts the donation of unarmed Unmanned Aerial Vehicles, from France, to be 56 used in a surveillance capacity only; 57 58 8. Affirms that once the Central African Republic's stability improves that the 59 transitional government ensures that fair and free elections occur; 60 9. Recommends the convening of diplomatic discussions between the parties to 61 62 the conflict in the Central African Republic.
