Statement by the President of the Security Council

At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 11 December 2013 in connection with the current situation in the Central African Republic. The President of the Security Council made the following statement on behalf of the Council:

The Security Council urges the states which committed troops to the United Nations Mission for the Verification of Human Rights in the Central African Republic (MINUCAR) and the Mission in the Central African Republic (MICAR) to fulfill these commitments as quickly as possible. The Council is thankful for the financial support from the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg and Australia, as well as to the United States for their contribution of transportation vehicles for peacekeepers and supplies. Applauding further troop commitments by Togo of 300 to 500 peacekeepers to the Support Mission for the Central African Republic (MISCA) and the United Kingdom of 1300 peacekeepers to MICAR, with transportation provided by both the United Kingdom and the United States.

The Security Council condemns the continuing human rights violations in the Central African Republic. The Council is steadfast in its support of the United Nations Declaration of Human Rights. Furthermore we thank the Kingdom of Morocco for their sending of field hospitals, medical supplies, and personnel.

The Security Council is confident in the recent actions taken by this body in supporting MICAR and MINUCAR will have a positive action.

We congratulate the efforts by the African Union and regional organizations such as MISCA and the United Nations Integrated Peace Building Office in the Central African Republic (BINUCA). The Security Council is confident that the new stabilization
