8 9 10 11	<i>Fully aware</i> that today's youth will one day be in charge of their respective nations and it is thus important to provide them with opportunities for leadership development,		
11 12 13 14 15	<i>Convinced</i> that the better integration of youth into society through the involvement of positive engagement leads to a feeling of self-worth, ability to more effectively express concerns and the overall improvement of their nation,		
16 17 18	<i>Emphasizing</i> the need to provide youth with positive ways to spend their time in order to prevent involvement in detrimental activities,		
19 20 21	<i>Noting</i> a lack of avenues for political representation of youth as a potential instigator of violent protests,
