SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in the Congo

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council -- 1961

The Historical Security Council – 1961,

1 *Deeply Concerned* about the growing humanitarian issues in the Congo,

2
3 *Recognizing* the diversity of parties disputing within the Congo,

4
5 *Affirming* that the United Nations Security Council must remain neutral in
6 allocation,

7
8 *Deeply conscious* of the trauma affecting the post-conflict areas,

9
10 *Fully aware* of the particularly vulnerable ethnic populations both within the
11 Congo and around the world,

12
13 *Having considered* the safety of United Nations peace keeping and humanitarian
14 workers,

15
16 1. *Calls upon* the distribution of humanitarian aid in the Congo, particularly
17 pertaining to the massive human need for:

- 18 (a) Medical assistance;
19 (b) Food and nutritional support;
20 (c) Temporary housing aid;

21
22 2. *Urges* a binary distributive model that provides:

- 23 (a) An urban distribution effort based on an initial baseline study that would be
24 temporarily constructed in:
25 (i) Leopoldville;
26 (ii) Stanleyville;
27 (iii) Elizabethville;
28 (iv) Kasai Provence;
29 (b) A rural mobile effort that will intend to target vulnerable populations;

30
31 3. *Solemnly affirms* the United Nations Security Council's intention to protect
32 humanitarian aid providers. This will be done through a peace keeping force with a
33 Chapter V mandate with the strict goal of protecting providers.
