*The Historical Security Council -- 1961,*

- 1 *Deeply Concerned* on the situation in El Salvador,
- 2
- 3 *Emphasizing* the Security Council's commitment to international peace and state
- 4 sovereignty,
- 5
- 6 1. *Authorizes* the creation of a fact finding mission to El Salvador for the express
- 7 goal of:
- 8 a) Describing the intentions of the government take over;
- 9 b) Further expounding upon the intention to respect national sovereignty;
- 10 c) Delineating the current status of respect for international Human Rights and
- 11 international normative law;
- 12 d) The composition of the fact-finding mission should be equally composed of
- 13 investigators from nations from the Non-alignment Movement, Western Nations, and the
- 14 Communist Nations;
- 15
- 16 2. *Authorizes* the dispensation of election observers to El Salvador for the
- 17 parliamentary elections of 1961.
- 18
- 19 3. *Further authorizes* the composition of the election observers to be equally
- 20 composed of individuals from the Non-Alignment Movement, Western Nations, and
- 21 Communist nations;
- 22
- 23 4. *Decides* to remain actively seized on the matter.
