SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Bosnia

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council -- 1993

The Historical Security Council -- 1993,

1 *Recognizing* the sovereignty of all nations,

2

3 *Deeply disturbed* by the loss of human life in the Balkan region,

4

5 *Noting with regret* the ineffectiveness of previous sanctions and cease fire
6 agreements,

7

8 *Alarmed* by the recent failure of aid delivery and distribution,

9

10 *Guided* by United Nations Protection Force's (UNPROFOR) efforts to provide
11 safe zones for refugees,

12

13 1. *Urges* the establishment of safe routes utilizing pre-existing transportation
14 routes connecting current safe zones to be determined upon recommendation from
15 UNPROFOR;

16

17 2. *Strongly recommends* the addition of 2,000 peacekeepers to ensure safe passage
18 of humanitarian workers and aid;

20 3. *Requests* that the specific roles of the peacekeepers be:

21 (a) Protect newly established routes in accordance with the current UNPROFOR
22 mandates that UN peacekeeping forces cannot engage in fire unless they are fired upon;

23 (b) Maintain checkpoints on the safe routes;

24 (c) Escort humanitarian aid transports between checkpoints and workers.
