1 2	Recognizing the sovereignty of all nations,
3	Deeply disturbed by the loss of human life in the Balkan region,
5 6	<i>Noting with regret</i> the ineffectiveness of previous sanctions and cease fire agreements,
7 8 9	Alarmed by the recent failure of aid delivery and distribution,
10 11 12	Guided by United Nations Protection Force's (UNPROFOR) efforts to provide safe zones for refugees,
13 14 15 16	1. <i>Urges</i> the establishment of safe routes utilizing pre-existing transportation routes connecting current safe zones to be determined upon recommendation from UNPROFOR;
17 18 19	2. Strongly recommends the addition of 2,000 peacekeepers to ensure safe passag of humanitarian workers and aid;
20 21 22	3. <i>Requests</i> that the specific roles of the peacekeepers be: (a) Protect newly established routes in accordance with the current UNPROFOR mandates that UN peacekeeping forces cannot engage in fire unless they are fired upon;
23 24	(b) Maintain checkpoints on the safe routes;(c) Escort humanitarian aid transports between checkpoints and workers.
