SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Bosnia

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council -- 1993

The Historical Security Council -- 1993,

- 1 *Recalling* all previous resolutions on the conflict in Bosnia-Herzegovina,
- 2
- 3 *Recognizing* the sovereignty, territorial integrity and political independence of
- 4 Bosnia-Herzegovina and the responsibility of the Security Council in this regard,
- 5
- 6 *Noting with regret* the breakdown of previous attempts at peace in the region,
- 7
- 8 *Emphasizing* the primary responsibility under the Charter of United Nations of
- 9 this body is the maintenance of international peace and security,
- 10
- 11 *Stressing* that a cease to the hostilities in Bosnia-Herzegovina is pivotal to achieve
- 12 meaningful progress towards peace in the region,
- 13
- 14 1. *Calls for* an immediate cease-fire and an end to hostilities in the region of
- 15 Bosnia and Herzegovina between all parties for the purpose of resolving the conflict
- 16 through peaceful negotiations;
- 17
- 18 2. *Strongly urges* participation by all parties involved in the dispute to partake in
- 19 negotiations for the purpose of establishing long term peace in the region;
- 20
- 21 3. *Further calls* for unhindered delivery of humanitarian aid, and further stresses
- 22 the idea that preventing the distribution of these items is a direct violation of international
- 23 humanitarian law;
- 24
- 25 4. *Requests* that all negotiations continue to take place in Geneva, Switzerland and
- 26 occur in no less than one month's time;
- 27
- 28 5. *Notes* its ability and willingness to consider taking any appropriate or necessary
- 29 measures to assist the parties involved to implement any agreement that may be reached
- 30 and fairly agreed on by all parties, which would require an action by the Council;
- 31
- 32 6. *Decides* to remain actively seized on the matter.
