SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Bosnia

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council -- 1993

The Historical Security Council -- 1993,

- 1 *Deeply concerned* by the plight facing the established safe zone of Sarajevo,
- 2
- 3 *Strongly reiterating* the necessity of continuing to provide humanitarian aid to the
- 4 safe zones,
- 5
- 6 *Deploing* the actions taken against the safe zone and the supply lines providing
- 7 humanitarian aid to the safe zones, particularly the supply line through Mt. Igman,
- 8
- 9 *Noting* that Resolution 816, which instituted the flight ban over Bosnia-
- 10 Herzegovina, does not prevent flights authorized by the United Nations Protection Force
- 11 (UNPROFOR) or humanitarian flights,
- 12
- 13 1. *Authorizes* the immediate implementation of air drops of humanitarian aid into
- 14 the safe zone of Sarajevo, with the humanitarian aid to consist of food, water, and
- 15 medical supplies;
- 16
- 17 2. *Directs* UNPROFOR coordinated with the help of the North Atlantic Treaty
- 18 Organization (NATO) to oversee and implement the air drops as well as the distribution
- 19 of aid acquired through these airdrops with the explicit approval of, and in coordination
- 20 with the Secretary General;
- 21
- 22 3. *Takes note* that the implementation of further air drops of humanitarian relief
- 23 supplies in other safe zones could occur if deemed necessary;
- 24
- 25 4. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
