	Strongly reiterating the necessity of continuing to provide humanitarian aid to the safe zones, Deploring the actions taken against the safe zone and the supply lines providing humanitarian aid to the safe zones, particularly the supply line through Mt. Igman,		
	<i>Noting</i> that Resolution 816, which instituted the flight ban over Bosnia-Herzegovina, does not prevent flights authorized by the United Nations Protection Force (UNPROFOR) or humanitarian flights,		
	1. <i>Authorizes</i> the immediate implementation of air drops of humanitarian aid into the safe zone of Sarajevo, with the humanitarian aid to consist of food, water, and medical supplies;		
	2.Directs UNPROFOR coordinated with the help of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) to oversee and implement the air drops as well as the distribution of aid acquired through these airdrops with the explicit approval of, and in coordination with the Secretary General;		
	3. <i>Takes note</i> that the implementation of further air drops of humanitarian relief supplies in other safe zones could occur if deemed necessary;		
	4. <i>Decides</i> to remain actively	y seized of the matter.
