The Historical Security Council -- 1993,

- 1 *Aware* of the seriousness of the ongoing situation in Bosnia,
- 2
- 3 *Reaffirming* the fact that the United Nations Security Council has a right to
- 4 protect all civilians in areas troubled by conflict,
- 5
- 6 *Disturbed* by the large number of civilians who have been displaced by the recent
- 7 attacks on the Bosnian capital of Sarajevo,
- 8
- 9 *Realizing* the need to take action immediately,
- 10
- 11 *Referencing* the United Nations Charter which allows the United Nations Security
- 12 Council to use force,
- 13
- 14 *Fully aware* of the dire shortage of peacekeepers in regards to the United Nations
- 15 Protective Force (UNPROFOR),
- 16
- 17 1. *Stresses* that targeting civilians and other protected personnel is a violation of
- 18 human rights;
- 19
- 20 2. *Reaffirms* that member states have the responsibility to intervene when a state
- 21 cannot adequately protect its people through a process set up by the Secretary-General
- 22 and when said state requests the intervention by the United Nations;
- 23
- 24 3. *Calls upon* the United Nations Security Council to take immediate action to
- 25 protect the civilians in Bosnia.

- 27 4. *Decides* to add 50,000 peacekeepers to UNPROFOR with additional forces to
- 28 be sent as deemed necessary by UNPROFOR.
